

CAMPGROUND RULES AND POLICIES

RESERVATION POLICIES

- Reservations require 100% payment at the time of booking.
- Reservation Cancellations or changes (other than holiday or special event weekends) require 72-hour notice from the date of check-in (i.e. Friday reservation must be cancelled by Tuesday). A \$13 fee (per site reserved) is non-refundable for all cancellations to cover processing fees.
- Refunds **will not be issued** for reservation cancellations or changes due to:
 - Inclement weather
 - Early departures
 - Cancellations on holiday or special event weekends
- Festival weekends require a 2-night stay (Friday, Saturday)
- Holiday weekends require a 3-night stay (e.g., Monday holiday requires Friday, Saturday, Sunday)
- Same day camping is welcome based upon availability
- Payment methods accepted: cash, check, Visa, Mastercard, Discover, and American Express
- Check-in time is 3:00 PM; Check-out time is 11:00 Am

CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Campground quiet time is 11:00 PM – 6:00 AM
- Campgrounds are patrolled by Park Rangers and Campbell County Police
- Dispose of trash properly in designated receptacles
- Children under age 18 must accompanied by a parent/guardian at all times
- Pets must be on a leash and accompanied by owner at all times; excessive barking is prohibited. Please pick up all pet waste and dispose of in trash receptacles.
- Prohibited campsite items and activities include, but are not limited to:
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Glass bottles
 - Firearms
 - Fireworks
 - Hunting
 - Lake swimming
 - Loud gatherings/parties
 - Portable toilets
 - Privacy tents
 - Non-licensed motor vehicle equipment, including golf carts and ATV's
- Music and other noise should not be heard beyond each campsite
- Park vehicles in designated areas only. Leave two wheels on pavement if parking on roadway.
- Picnic tables should remain in their current location. Please do not move them between campsites.
- Smoking and pets are prohibited in restrooms, bathhouses, and Yurts.
- No defacing signs, buildings, or any other structures in the park.
- Firewood is available for sale at the Ranger Station. Please do not bring firewood from outside the park or cut down trees inside the park for wood.
- Fires must be contained in the fire rings provided. Fires should never be left unattended and should be extinguished before turning in for the night or leaving the campground.
- All activities in the campground are at your own risk. Campbell County is not responsible for injury to campers, guests, or for loss of valuables of any kind, including damage from natural causes.
