

Rules & Policies

All participants are expected to respect the camps, trails, and fellow riders and behave in a manner conducive to family fun.

The following campground rules and policies apply to all guests:

- No alcohol
- No smoking in or around barn
- Trails close at dark
- Pets must be kept on a leash. Clean up after your pet
- Stalls must be stripped (including hay) prior to leaving or you will be charged \$20.00 per stall
- All campers must clean up after themselves and their horses, including hay and manure at the barn, in the campground, in parking areas, and any time riding requires a brief roadway section.
- You are only permitted to tack your horse in the campground. No washing or feeding horses in campground due to state water quality regulations and best management practices. The wash area is located at the barn
- State Law requires a current Negative Coggins and Health Certificate for each horse
- No picketing
- Be respectful of others. Offensive behavior will not be tolerated
- Keep your horse at a walk while in the campground and around barn
- Quiet time is 11:00 PM
- Horses are not permitted in the lake
- Campbell County reserves the right to shut down all trails for maintenance or inclement weather
